



Jack Attack - Practice

From Mat

- Challenge: Delivering strategic jacks
- Objective: See how many jacks you can land within the grid
- Roll 10 jacks to the 1M x 1M grid at 21M (23M on non-Canada greens!).
- Your objective is to land your jacks within the grid
- Roll all 10 jacks back to the mat which has a 2M x 1M grid around it. Your objective is to land your jacks within the grid (or on the mat! You can also remove the mat but I like the added challenge)
- Now roll all 10 jacks from the mat **through** the 21M grid and land them within the 2M x 1M grid located at the 32M mark
- Finally, roll all 10 jacks back from the 32M grid back to the mat.

Game Play

- For each jack that lands within the grid = 2pts
- For each jack that lands either side of the grid (but stays in bounds) = 1pt
- For each jack that is short or long of the grid = no points
- BONUS - Any jacks that end up on top of the mat = 5pts
- Any jacks that end up in the ditch deduct 5 pts

- You need 10 jacks, but less or more works too
- Set your rink up per the diagram; feel free to add grids or change lengths
- You are rolling 40 jacks in total during this practice,, there are 80 total points available (not including bonus mat points or deductions if you hit the ditch).
- How many points did you score?
